2.	Cutting paper.	Lacerations to fingers or hand	Avoid contact with blade. Unlock handle.
3.	Removing waste paper.	Lacerations to fingers or hand	Lock blade down.
			Avoid contact with blade.
4.	Moving paper cutter.	Lacerations, especially to fingers	Make sure handle is locked down.
			Avoid contact with blade by picking up paper cutter by non-blade edges.
			Hold paper cutter with blade away from body. Be aware of co-workers or bystanders as you perform this task.
