Slips, trips, falls	Inspect work area and remove hazards prior to start of work Barricade the work area with signs, cones, caution tape, etc. if necessary Set up temporary guard rails or use personal fall protection if working near unprotected ledges and skylights. Use scaffolds, aerial lifts, or other equipment if necessary Wear slip resistant shoes or boots Submit assist tags if necessary	
	Fall from ladder	Select appropriate ladder for the job Inspect the ladder before use Use according to manufacturer's recommendations 3 points of contact while climbing up and down Training on ladder safety Open A frames all the way Tie extension ladders if possible or have someone hold it	
	Biological, chemical and potential hazardous dust inhalation	Wear appropriate PPE: N95, Tyvek suit, gloves, eye protection Open ventilation	
	Legionella	Option to get water tested if necessary Submit an assist for flushing and cleaning if necessary	
	Musculoskeletal injuries	Use safe body mechanics and safe lifting techniques Morning stretch and flex Use dollies, stair climbers, and other material handling and lifting equipment when necessary	
	Chemical use/exposure/inhalation	Wear appropriate PPE: gloves, eye protection, N95 HazCom training If you notice unusual cough, eye, or throat irritation, remove yourself from the environment	
	Energized equipment/release of stored energy	De-energize all equipment and perform LOTO
